

Act in the reign of Victoria 21-06-1847

An Act was passed in the reign of Victoria for removing the Market between King Street and Castle Street in the Town of Sheffield and for providing a new Market Place in lieu thereof and for regulating and maintaining the Markets and fairs of the said town.

Act in the reign of King George 1V 27-06-1872

An Act was passed in the reign of King George which was an Act for enlarging the Market Place and regulating the markets within the Town of Sheffield in the West Riding of Yorkshire and for widening and rendering more safe and commodious several streets adjoining or leading into the said Market Place and for taking down the said Slaughter Houses within the said town and erecting others in a more proper situation.
